

Track Descriptions

Visual Arts

Grades K-3 – Water Color

These young artists will explore the world using shapes, colors and a paintbrush. They will have the opportunity to put it all together in an exciting landscape painting.

Grades 4-5 – Photography

Children will experience life through the lens of a camera and see the world in a new and exciting way. They will get hands on training with digital cameras as well as cover terms like; aperture, focus, shutter, exposure, metering, etc.

Students need to bring their own digital camera and instruction book to this class.

Culinary Arts

Grades 2-3 - Cake Decorating

Young bakers will work with chocolate molds, learn frosting techniques, mold and shape with fondant and finally decorate cakes for the Friday night showcase.

Grades 4-5 – Culinary

These young chefs will get hands on experience in a commercial kitchen. They will prepare snacks, learn about kitchen safety, and prepare the banquet for our Friday night showcase.

Creative Craftsmanship

Grades K-3 – Mixed Bag

Children will do a variety of craft projects using lots of different media; paint, glue, crayons, etc.

Grades 2-3 – Knitting/Crocheting

Learn to crochet and knit and bring home a project that can be used in the house or worn. Crochet hooks, knitting needles and yarn provided.

Creative Craftsmanship

Grades 4-5 – Sewing

Learn the proper use and care of a sewing machine while making muslin pillowcases. Take your sewing skills and contribute to an Arts Camp quilt to be displayed at church.

Grades 4-5 – 3/D art/sculpture

Using wire sculptures of the human form, each child will demonstrate their appreciation for an activity they enjoy (soccer, ballet, archery, etc.). The focus will be living an active life with appreciation for the gifts we've received.

Performing Arts

Grades K-1 – Music

Move & groove to your own tunes. This will be a hands on musical experience for those students who already love to play instruments or are interested in learning.

Grades K-1 – Dance

Learn key terminology and basic steps of dance and learn and perform a choreographed dance at the Friday night banquet.

Grades K-5 – Spanish

Join us as we venture into learning about the Spanish language and culture. The language will come alive as we experientially learn about, touch, and taste topics such as colors, foods, and geography. Instructors have lived in and/or traveled to locales such as Guatemala, Mexico, Costa Rica, and Nicaragua, and will share their experiences an authentic recipes, stories, and mementos. We will sing in Spanish at the Friday night banquet.

Grades 4-5 – Drama

Students will learn basic skills in improvisation, character development, and interpersonal interaction. The class will take a hands-on approach with interactive games and role-playing.
